Vehicle Details.

The goal is to purchase a late model police vehicle. The car will be customized with D.A.R.E. graphics and emergency lighting equipment. The car will not be used for any law enforcement activities. It will strictly be used to promote this program.

Start-up and ongoing funding will be needed for many things including the vehicle itself, customizations, educational material and handouts, vehicle maintenance, vehicle insurance, fuel, etc.
